

## Stabilisation of the critically ill child

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to identify good practice and areas for improvement in the quality of care provided to patients **0-18**<sup>th</sup> **birthday** who are critically ill and require stabilisation; and to review the impact of delivering that care on staff, patients and parent carers
- Patients will be identified for inclusion between 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 31<sup>st</sup> March
  2025 via hospital patient administration systems and via paediatric critical care transport team records, where they were:
  - ➤ Admitted to critical care (level 2 (PHDU/HDU) or level 3 (PICU/ICU) care)
  - Seen in the Emergency Department and have one of the included SNOMED CT or OPCS codes (listed separately)
  - Transferred to another hospital
  - Discussed with a critical care/paediatric transport/retrieval team during stabilisation
  - Transferred by a critical care/paediatric transport/retrieval team
- Additional data collection will include:
  - Clinical questionnaires
  - Organisational questionnaires
  - Case note review
  - > Patient, parent carer and clinician surveys
- Clinical reviewers will be recruited for the peer review of case notes. Please email: stabilisation@ncepod.org.uk for more information
